

GUJARAT PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

On Line applications are invited for the posts of ASSISTANT INSPECTOR OF MOTOR VEHICLE - Class-3 (Advt.- 100/2018-19) between date 15/11/2018, 13.00 Hrs. to date 30/11/2018, 13.00 Hrs.

(2) Candidates are instructed to visit Notice Board or the Web site of Commission <https://gpsc-ojas.gujarat.gov.in> for all provisions of advertisement, General Instructions, and the method of on line application.

- (1) Candidate shall carefully read the Advertisement No. and Name of the Post before Applying online. Candidates shall confirm the application only after verifying the details filled in the application form.
- (2) Any request or representation to correct any error or omission in the confirmed online application, or information filled in by the candidates shall not be accepted.
- (3) In case of more than one online application made by the candidate, only the latest confirmed application will be considered by the Commission. For candidates belonging to unreserved category the last confirmed application with fees will be considered by the Commission.
- (4) Candidates shall keep ready the certificate required in case of eligibility for interview(in the order mentioned in the general instructions)

- 1). The disabled candidates are not eligible for this post.
 - 2). Out of total posts 03 posts are reserved for Ex-Servicemen.
 - 3). In case of non availability of Women candidates in the respective category, the post so reserved will be allotted to male candidates belonging to the same category.
 - 4). The candidates belonging to reserved category can apply against vacancies for Unreserved Category but the criteria for selection will be applicable as per Unreserved Category. However, such candidates shall have to mention his reserve category specifically in the application.

Education Qualification :- (A) (1) Possess a Diploma in Mechanical Engineering (3 yrs. course) or Diploma in Automobile Engineering (3 yrs. course) or (2) a Degree in Mechanical engineering or Automobile Engineering of a recognized University or deemed university.

(B) The candidate shall possess a motor driving license of motor cycle and light motor vehicles at the time of appointment.

(C) The Candidate shall obtain a driving license of heavy goods vehicles or heavy passenger motor vehicles during the stipulated period of service on contractual basis.

(D) The candidate shall possess the basic knowledge of Computer Application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Service Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967

(E) The candidate shall possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.

(F) The candidate shall possess the following minimum physical standards:

(i) **For Male candidate:** Height not less than 162 centimeters (for Schedule Tribes of Gujarat Origin height 155 centimeters) and minimum chest measurement of 79 centimeters deflated and weight 50 Kg.

(ii) **For Female candidate:** Height not less than 158 centimeters (for Schedule Tribes of Gujarat Origin height 151 centimeters) and weight 45 Kg.

(iii) A candidate shall not be color blind and have clear vision with or without glasses in both eyes.

PAY: - The appointment to the selected candidates on the post of the Assistant inspector of motor vehicles, class-III will be given by the Government by taking into consideration the terms and conditions as prescribed under the recruitment rules. The candidate appointed shall be given, at the end of contractual period, the prescribed pay scale of the post of assistant inspector of motor vehicles, class-III, on his /her performance being found satisfactory during the stipulated period of service on contractual basis. This pay will be subject to the final decision of the Honorable Supreme Court for SLP No: 14124-14125/2012 admitted for the same purpose.

AGE:-Not less than **19** years and not more than **35** years. Age will be calculated on the last date of the receipt of application.

Upper Age limit shall be relaxed as under:

Important provisions:

(1) The candidate who has shown the details of sports in online application, such candidate should invariably produce the certificate of sports issued by the competent authority as per provision of GAD Circular No-CRR/1077/2660/G2, dated 25/2/80 to the Commission within 10 days from the date of written test with a printed copy of online application and call letter. If such certificate is not submitted within the stipulated time by the candidate, it will be considered that he/she does not possess certificate. Sports certificate submitted by the candidate will be scrutinised. Only those candidates whose sports certificates are in conformity with above referred Circular of GAD will be eligible to get 5% of the additional marks of the obtained marks in written test.

MODE OF EXAMINATION:

(1) There will be a written test for selection. There will be one question paper in written test which will be of objective and multiple choice type.

- (2) The Question Paper will be of 3 hours and it will be of 250 marks which consists of Part-A and Part-B. Part-A of Question paper will be of either Mechanical Engineering or Automobile engineering of 200 marks. In which Part-I will consist of 100 Questions, each of one mark and Part-II will consist of 200 Questions each of one half mark. The level of question paper will be of diploma Mechanical Engineering or Automobile engineering. The medium of question paper will be English and Gujarati. Part-B will be of Gujarati language of 50 marks consist of 50 Questions each of one mark. The level of question paper will be of 12th standard Gujarat Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board. Candidates have to choose an option in the application form for Mechanical Engineering or Automobile Engineering subject.
- (3) Entry in written examination is provisional and without any scrutiny of the application.
- (4) Result of Question paper of Part-A will be prepared by using suitable scaling formula.
- (5) The Commission shall declare the Provisional result of written examination. About three times of number of category wise candidates will be considered for the advertised posts. All the necessary documents and other details of candidates will be verified according to Recruitment Rules, Exam rules and important provisions of the advertisement. This verification includes Physical Examination of candidates. After all this verification final result will be declared according to total number of vacancy.

Note: The candidates having qualification from foreign University Should produce necessary documents /proof regarding the recognition/equivalence of their degree. It will be the responsibility of the candidate to produce necessary documents in time. Commission will not consider any representation about this.

Application fee: Candidates of General Category have to pay Rs.100/- as Application fee. While candidates of Ex-service man, Reserved Category of Gujarat State & candidates who is physically disable have not to pay application fee. While candidates of Reserved Category of Other States have to apply in unreserved category and have to pay application fee.
